CALL FOR PAPERS

Disaster Management is now considered as a globally important topic and efforts are being made to mitigate disasters through integration of different stakeholders. Existing and rapidly growing densely populated urban areas of most developing countries do not have adequate safety measures. Major disasters like Haiti Earthquake (2010), Japan Earthquake and Tsunami (2011), Nepal Earthquake (2015), and the recent climate change related events indicate increased global vulnerability to disasters.
