Facilitate students to discover their hidden potential, and hone up their life skills Expose students to industry work culture during their course of study.

Facilitate students to find careers of their choice by interfacing with the Industry experts.

How do we mitigate our objectives?

The process

Once a student takes admission and settles down in the University environment, we establish contact with student(s) either in a group or one to one to understandtheir careeraspirations and the challenges they face in achieving them.

As about 70-80% students comes from the rural background, we focus more on improving the communication skills of our students in first two Semesters of their study. We do an assessment on the students and group students either in basic or advance level of training. The students are also put though the practice sessions in the state of the art communication lab to improve their pronunciation.

In the year 2onwards, the students are put through 40 hours of structured program covering Life, Employability & Corporate/ Social skills. The details of the topic which we cover are as under

Life skills:

- Identifying strengths and weaknesses through SWOT analysis
- Generating Self-esteem and confidence and positive attitude
- Understanding values, beliefs and tips for cultivating new habits
- setting values based career goals



- Overcoming fear of failure by staying focused and committed
- Managing time and anger effectively.

Employability skills:

- · Developing effective interpersonal skills
- · Developing effective presentation skills
- Effective presentation of resume and cover letter
- honing up group discussion and Interview facing skills

Corporate & Social skills:

- Understanding emotional intelligence for professional success
- Understanding corporate etiquettes with reference to real life corporate
- Scenario

Besides, our students are also regularly exposed to interactive sessions with the Industry experts through Seminars, Guest Lectures, Conferences, and Corporate Meets. Such activities helps them to sharpen their academic knowledge and keeps them abreast with the latest developments across sectors.

This gives a much-desired exposure to students and they are also able to feel the pulse, which they shall require tomorrow when they actually become a part of any organization. Our students have to undergo through One Semester mandatory internship program during the course of their study. The evaluation of their learning and practical experience is strictly based on the detail report & Viva presentation.
