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1. National Moot Court Competition @SLCS

The two day National Moot Competition was organized on 6th April 2019 by Shobhit Deemed University, Meerut's School of Law and Constitutional Studies, Modipuram. For the very first time this competition was organized in Meerut district of western Uttar Pradesh and Shobhit University became the first law college of Meerut to conduct National Moot court.

During the preliminary session of the National Moot Court Competition, Dr. Rashmi Khurana Nagpal, Dean of Law Department, greeted everyone and told the importance of the competition, saying that it is essential for the student's overall growth. Students that compete in these

tournaments get to know about the complexities of the courtroom throughout their studies, which will come in handy later in their legal careers. He stated that 18 courtrooms have been prepared to ensure the smooth running of the competition; in each courtroom, two teams will compete, one representing the claimant and the other representing the defendant before the judge. Similarly, the team who represented the claimant in the previous phase will now represent the defendant in the following step.

Mr. Kunwar Shekhar Vijendra, Chancellor Shobhit University, told that being a true human being is just as important as being a competent advocate. By moving away from the pros and cons, young students may play an essential role in society. Congratulations for hosting the inaugural National Moot Court, and best of luck to the students. He stated that while the competition belongs to just one team, the disadvantaged team should learn from it rather than be unhappy.

Guest of Honour, Shri Rajesh Chandra, Judge (Retd.) Allahabad High Court, said at the event's inauguration ceremony, "I wish the university would organise such events in our time as well." He praised Shobhit University for its efforts to promote legal research and education in western Uttar Pradesh.

Prof. A.P. Garg, the University's Vice Chancellor, blessed all of the participants for their efforts. Mr. Mahesh Kumar Mishra, Professor of Law and Administrative Director of the University, extended his appreciation to all of the visitors.



The Moot Court competition's concluding ceremony began with Chief Guest, Allahabad High Court Judge B. Amit. Sthalekar, and Chancellor Kunwar Shekhar Vijendra lighting the lamp in

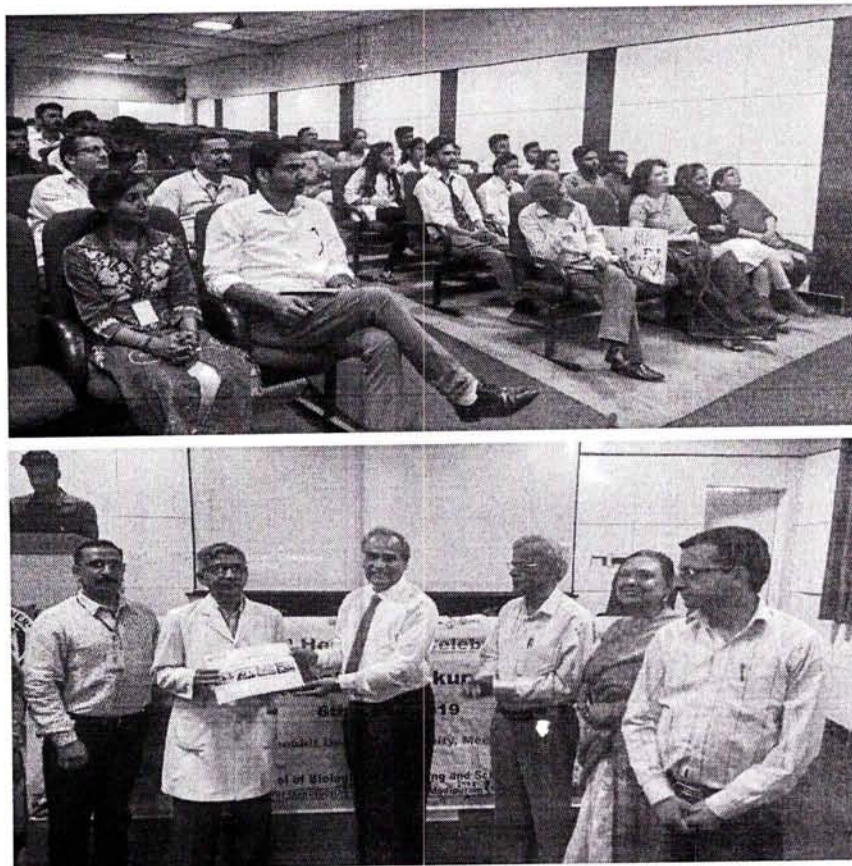
front of Maa Saraswati. Saraswati. The final round was judged by a bench consisting of Allahabad High Court Justice B.Amit. Sthalekar, Justice Rajesh Chandra, Justice Pramod Kumar Goel, and Supreme Court senior attorney Surat Singh were present. The Army Institute of Law Punja gives a stiff fight and won first place in the competition, with the team from UPES Dehradun coming in second. First award for best memorial, first award for Shastra Deemed University, second memorial award to Rajiv Gandhi National Law University, and best researcher award to Ji Wenyu Shree, as well as best motor male, went to Rajiv Gandhi National Law University. Harnoor Deep Kaur and Archana Upadhyay shared for first place in Female, which was won jointly by Pranav Kaushik and Best Mooter.

Judge B Amit Sthalekar of the Allahabad High Court, who was there as the program's principal guest, stated that there is a significant difference between the study of law in earlier times and the study of law now. Previously, Students did not have access to this information. In today's world, students prepare for the Supreme Court through contests such as Moot Court, know the Supreme Court's Code of Ethics, and learn about the Supreme Court's Code of Ethics through the Internet and technology. It aids in the conduct of case studies and is readily available. Whereas in the past, major attorneys were hesitant to fight in the Supreme Court, today's students are directly arguing in the Supreme Court because of such facilities available within institutions, and they commended Shobhit University's Moot Court competition.

2. Celebration of World Health Day

On the occasion of World Health Day Celebrations-2019, Shobhit University's School of Biological Engineering and Life Sciences conducted a free health check-up camp. The course was conducted collaborated with Meerut's Dr. Garg Multispecialty and Orthodontics Centre. Throughout the camp, over a hundred cases were diagnosed. The dental examination was performed by Dr. Anshul Garg, an Orthodontic Surgeon.

Blood pressure, SPO2, pulse rate, heart rate, blood group, and other parameters were examined by biological engineering and science students. Anurag specialist Nutricharge was also there, and he recommended a variety of dietary supplements to help in physical issues. Prof. Tung Veer Singh, Professor and Head, Medicine, LLRM Medical College, Meerut, gave an invited talk on health economics. They talked about the growing expense of medical care as well as the many treatment choices available.



3. Workshop on Green Energy Production

Under the auspices of Shobhit University's Technology Business Incubator, a special lecture on Green Energy Production was held as part of the ongoing workshop on "Waste on Commercial Activated Carbon." Prof. Subodh Kumar Bhatnagar, former Professor and Dean Department of Biotechnology, Sardar Patel University, was present as the major guest and provided the students with great knowledge concerning conventional and unconventional energy sources.

He said that algae come in different forms, each with its own set of properties. They utilise the sun's energy to make carbohydrates, fatty acids, proteins, and vitamins, among other things, from which the fatty acids are extracted and converted into biodiesel via a chemical reaction. In this regard, India began producing biodiesel from algae in 2008, 2009, and 2010 as a result of international conferences. The production of biomass is the quickest.

Professor Dr. AP Garg, the University's Vice Chancellor, who was present at the programme, told that Green Energy is the future of civilization, that it is the only alternative to protect the environment, and there is a need to make this technology more accessible and affordable. Professor PD Sharma thanked everyone at the end of the workshop.



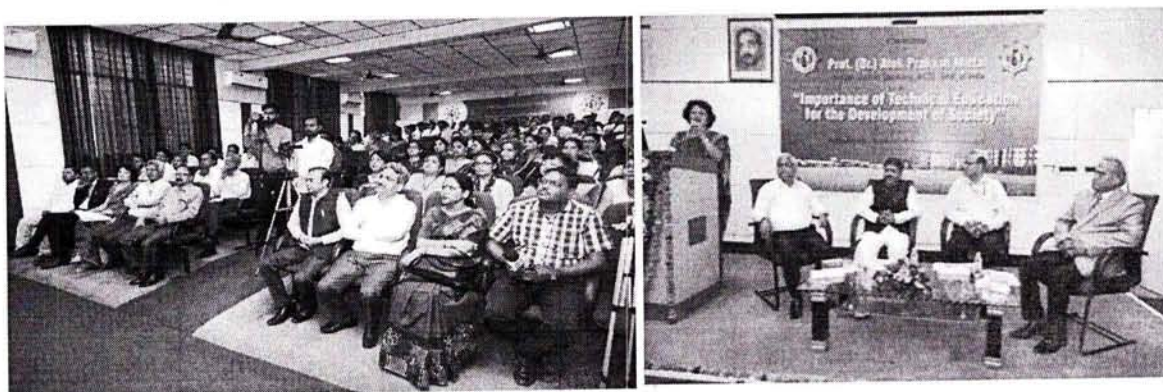
4. Invited talk by Prof. (Dr.) Alok Prakash Mittal Honorable Member Secretary, AICTE, Govt. Of India.

Shri Dr. Alok Prakash Mittal, praising Shobhit University, told that the university would gain new heights in the future because of the manner it encourages innovation and research.

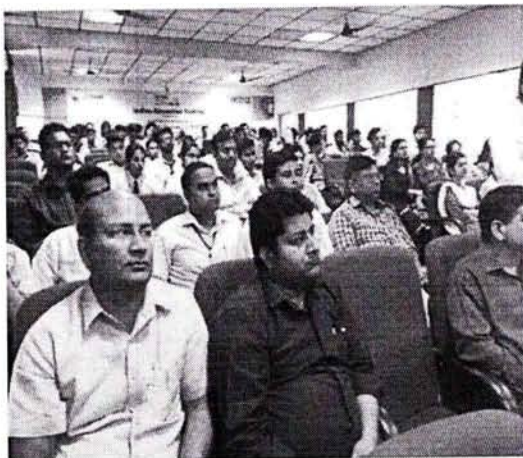


5. Indian Education Festival in collaboration with CEGR

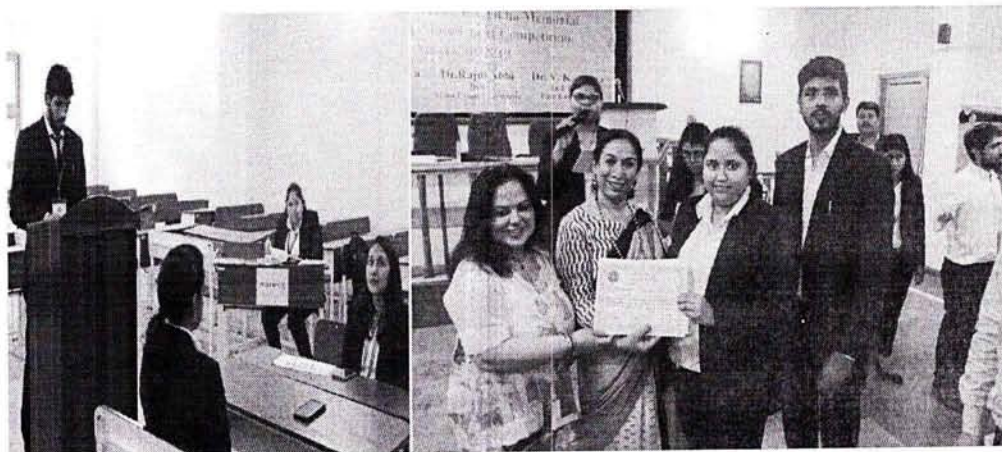

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7. National Seminar on Emerging Trends In Bio- Electronics and Informatics .

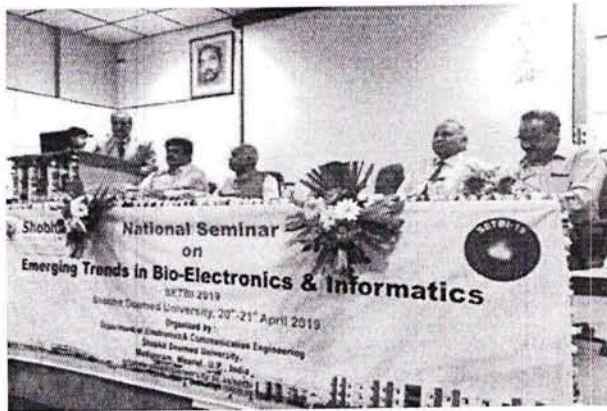

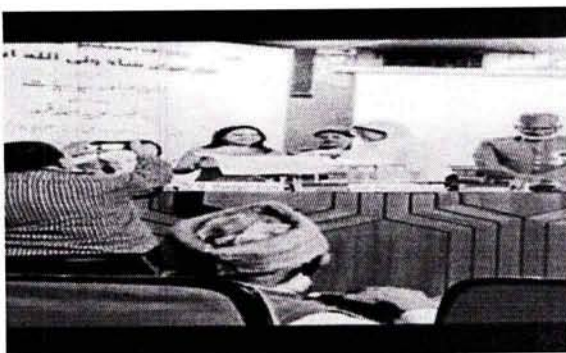


8. National Award was presented to Dr. Anita Rathore, Head of the Department of Yoga at Shobhit University.

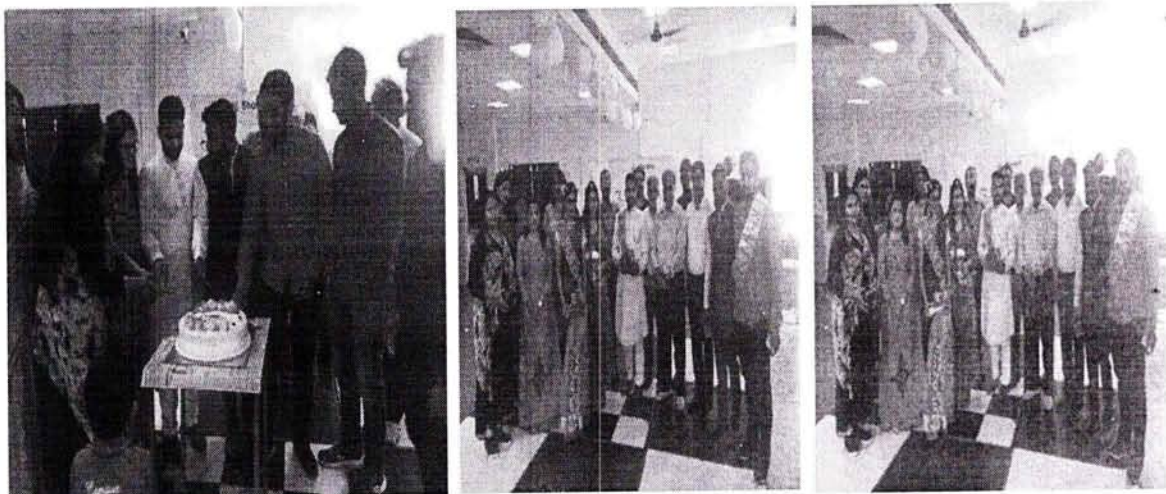

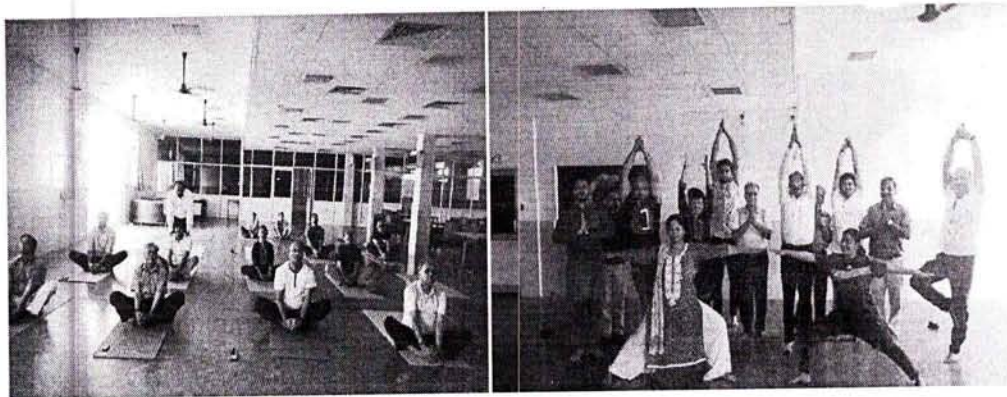


13. Ten Days Yoga Camp organized by Centre for Yoga and Research

briefed the group on the university's business development, agricultural research, and engineering education offered to students using current technologies.



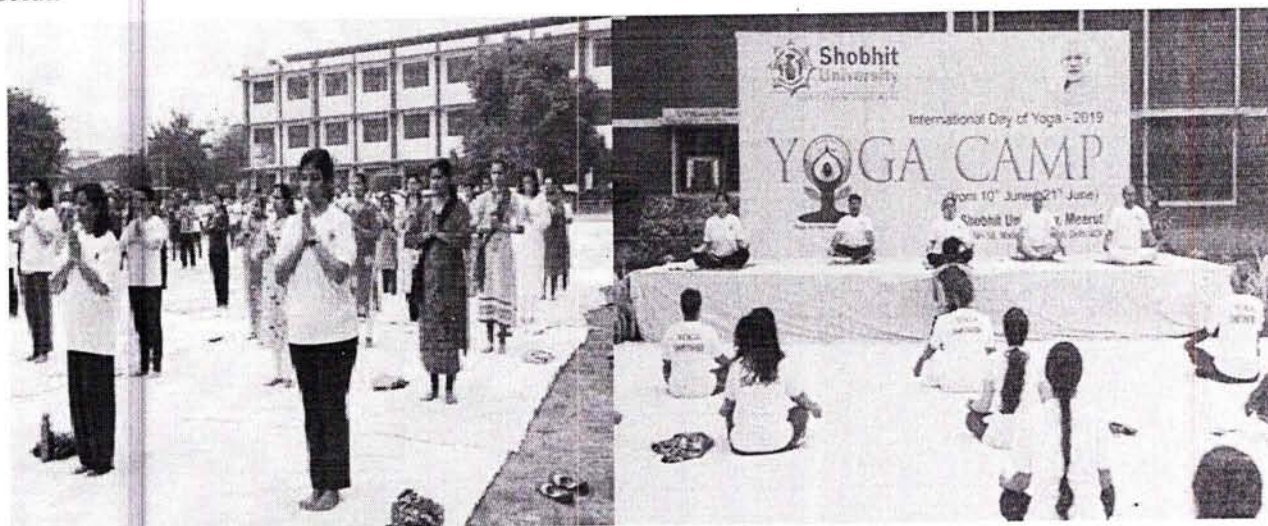
15. International Yoga Day Celebrated

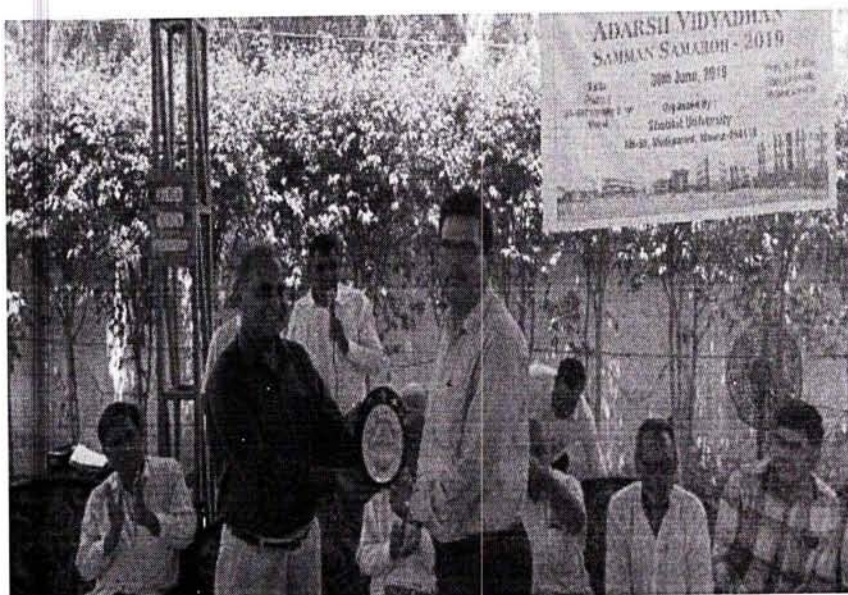


16. Adarsh Vidyadhan Samman Samaroh

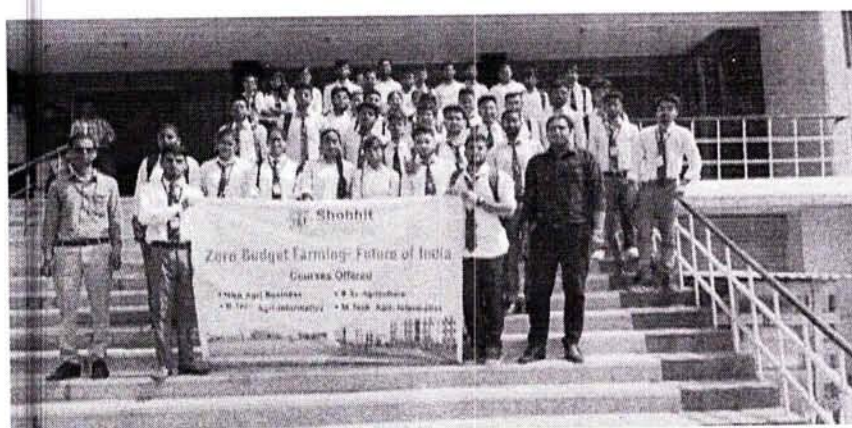

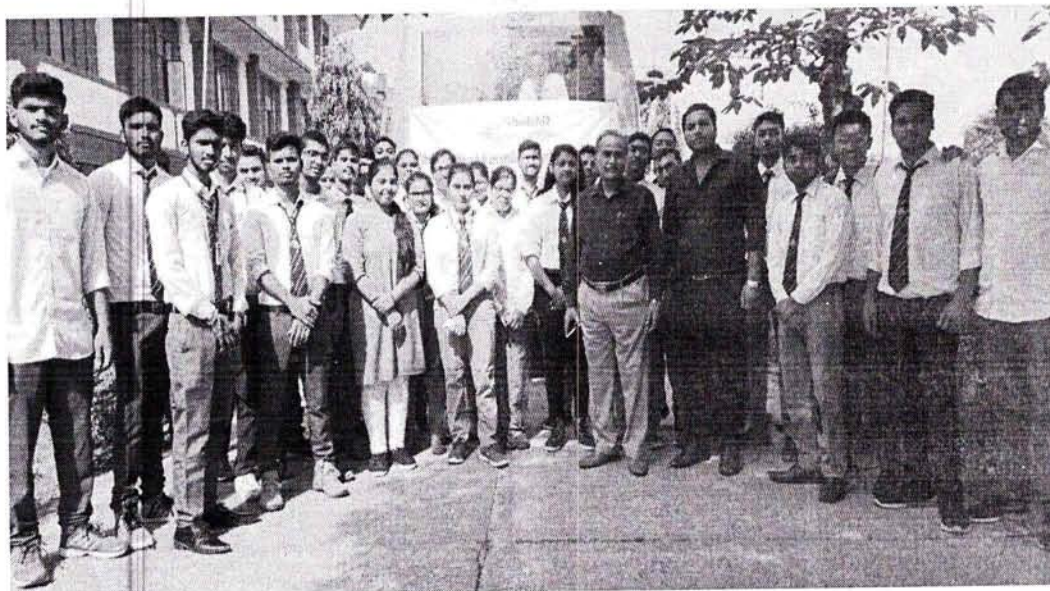
praised Shobhit University, saying that it provides superior education to kids in our region, thus our youngsters do not need to go away from Meerut. I wish you the best of luck.

20. Innovation @ Shobhit University

Paridhi Goel, a Shobhit University student Department of Bioinformatics student, delivered speech on the diagnosis of 11 different forms of cardiac disorders, consists of heart attack, bundle branch block, cardiomyopathy, dysrhythmia, heart failure, hypertropia, myocardia tic, stable engines, and unstable engines. According to the student, this programme can assist physicians in detecting early indications of numerous cardiac defects. Until now, study on 1-2 disorders connected to heart disease has been done, but for the first time, research has been done on 11 different forms of heart issues. Doctors check it using an ECG to discover abnormalities connected to heart disease.

However, due to a variety of issues that arise in the human body, the particular problem is frequently not discovered. This programme may be a better alternative for resolving this issue.

The student stated that she conducted her research by the MIT (PTV) database in the United States. This study involved 216 persons ranging in age from 17 to 87 years old. Professor Shakti Dev Mukherjee and Dr. Maya Dutt Joshi checked out this research project. For the last four years, the student had been conducting study on this topic. Professor AK Saxena AIIMS Patna, Vice Chancellor HN Verma Jaipur National University, and expert RC Dubey of Vedic Biological Science investigated the student's study work. Those who praised the student's study and efforts told that in the future, persons with heart disease would be detected at an early stage and treated on time as a result of this research work.



21. Free Medical Camp at Shobhit University

Shobhit University, LLRM Medical College, and Dr Garg Multispecialty Dental Clinic and

Orthodontic Center collaborated to hold a free medical camp in Meerut's Maithna Indrajit Village. 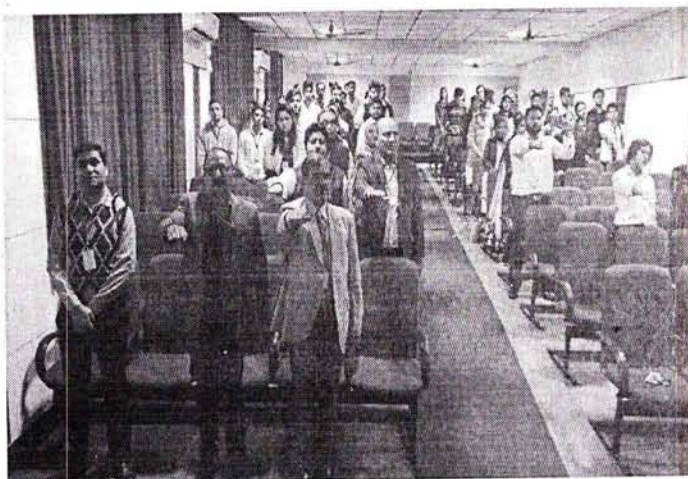
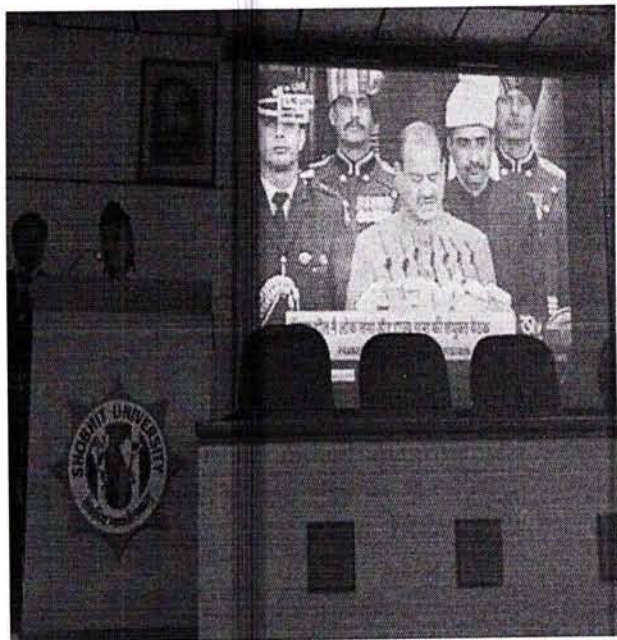

24. Innovation of Solar-powered automobile by Mechanical Department

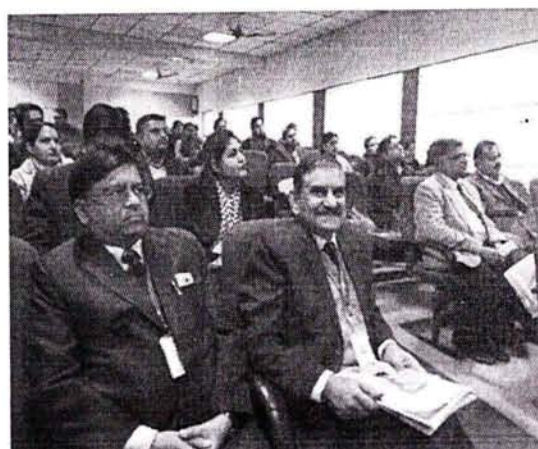
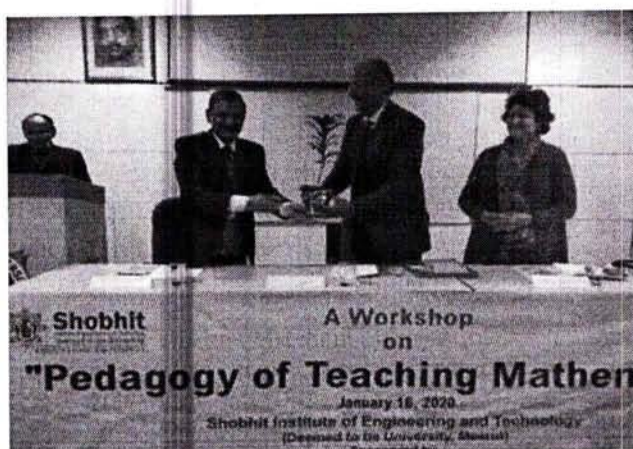

According to them, this automobile will reach a top speed of 40 kilometers per hour! They not only taught them about the attributes of the automobile, but they also taught them about its power! This automobile is powered by a 48-volt BLDC motor, according to them! Students said that because this automobile operates on solar energy rather than petroleum, it is a significant step toward minimizing global warming and keeping the environment clean. An extra reward of ₹ 40,000 was given to them by the University. The university honoured the national and international players of western Uttar Pradesh, who have won the national and international level, by giving a memento by the Chancellor of the university.

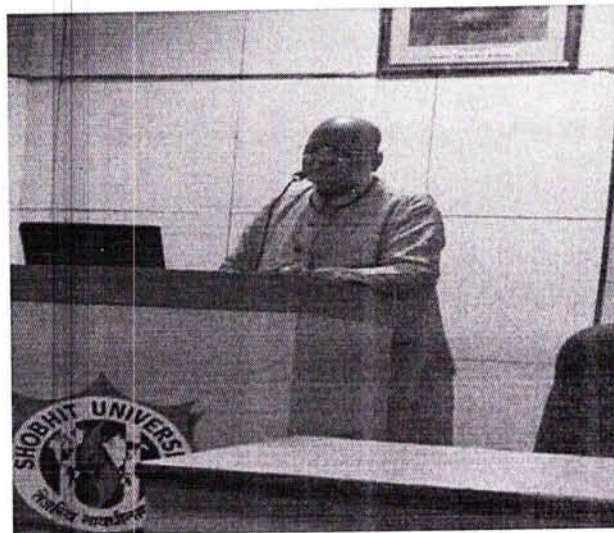
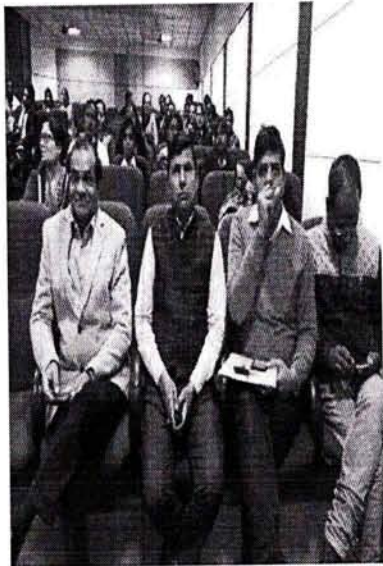


29. Guest Lecture on Corona virus

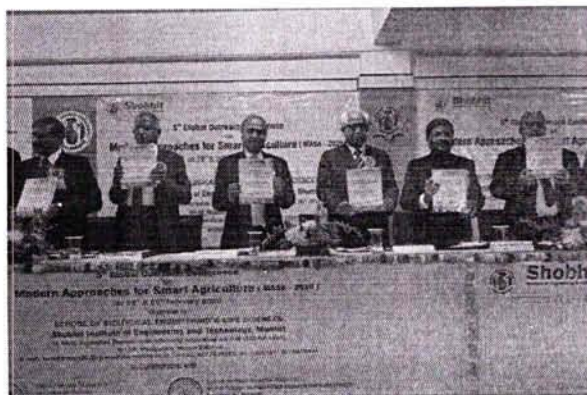

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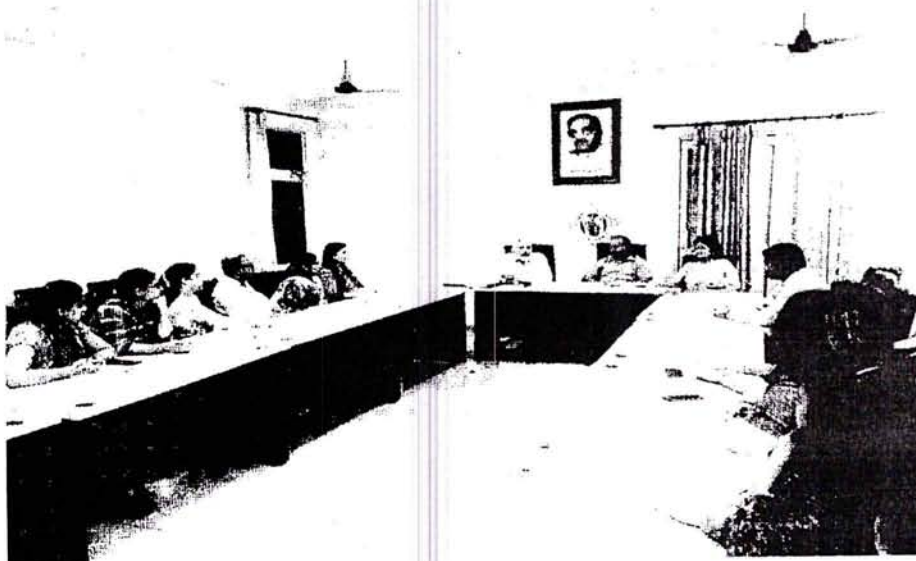

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36. Report on Workshop on "Understanding the ongoing Economic Slowdown"

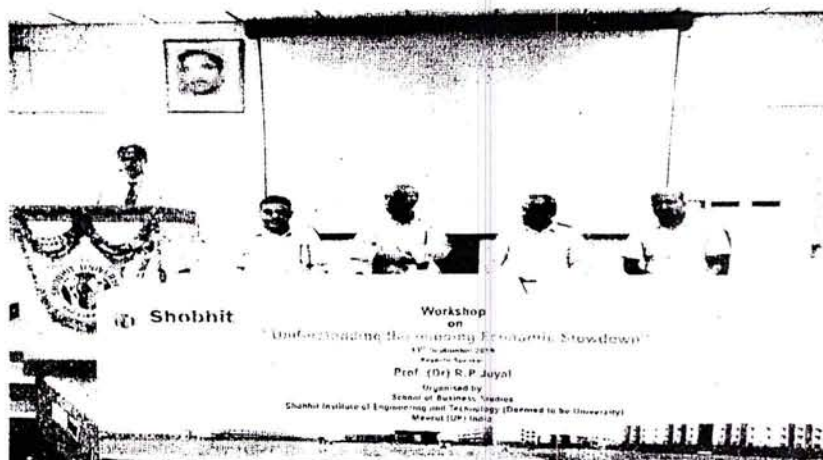

An International Conference “5th Global Outreach Conference on Modern Approaches for Smart Agriculture (MASA- 2020)”, was organized in the University on 28-29 February, 2020 by School of Biological Engineering & Life Sciences of Shobhit Institute of Engineering and Technology (Deemed-to-be-University) Meerut in collaboration with Gorea Charitable Foundation, Jaipur (Rajasthan) and the Society for Plant Research (Vegetos). 

Two-day International e-Seminar on Biodiversity and Human Welfare

On the occasion of World Environmental Day, a two-day International e-Seminar on "Biodiversity and Human Welfare" was organized by the School of Biological Engineering and Life Sciences.

International Meet on Preparation of Home Quarantine Schedule/Protocol

Dated: 15-06-2020 and 16-06-2020, on Zoom

Hon'ble The Chancellor Kunwar Shekhar Vijendra opened the International Meet with the remarks that under the present pressure of COVID-19 on medical infrastructure and medical staff, India needs a “Home Quarantine Protocol / System” to reduce the burden on hospitals so that our resources may be more focused and utilized for the treatment of critically ill patients and we may reduce the fatality rate and improve our recover rate in this pandemic era.

Prof Amar Garg introduced the speakers to the audience and readout the “Home Quarantine Schedule” which was discussed at length with following members on Zoom conference yesterday on 15-06-2020.

Home Quarantine Schedule Suggested by International Experts:

1. Prof. Amar P. Garg, Vice Chancellor, Shobhit Deemed Univ., Meerut
2. Prof. Bernard Paul, University of Burgundy, France
3. Mr. Bajeerao Patil, Clinical Director, Kirkbride Centre, USA
4. Dr. Sunil Nayak, European Institute of Health, Europa, Germany
5. Professor Amina Ather, Former Professor UNESCO and Prof Emeritus, China, presently in Germany
6. Ms. Maryam Salahuddine, Dubai
7. Mr. Nadeem, Founder Director, Institute of Designs, with centres in Thailand, China, India and other countries

The panelists were asked to discuss the importance of each and every factor and the final protocol/schedule was drawn which is given below here.

Two of the above experts have recently recovered from COVID-19 without taking any medicines, and just used Home Quarantine/Isolation. Rest experts are advising various Covid-19 infected people to treat them at home.

Symptoms of COVID-19:

1. Dry throat, dry cough, with sneezing
2. Headache, body pain, high fever
3. Shortening of breathing

4. Highly variable and different from person to person

Requirements for Home Quarantine:

1. Well ventilated Separate room with WC
2. All necessary toiletries and cleaning appliances
3. Study table, TV, Lap-top, mobile with charger, bank debit card, online games, internet, reading books / material as per habits
4. A small hot plate for warming / boiling water and other material
5. Clothes as per requirement
6. Oxygen cylinder with respiratory device for emergency
7. All medicines for the diseases from already suffering like diabetes, BP, asthma, heart, kidney, stomach *etc.*
8. Keep a thermometer, BP apparatus, sugar measurement kit, pulse oxymeter, and normal medicines like paracetamol, and all other medicines for minor illnesses.
9. Adequate quantity of mask and gloves, hand sanitizer, soap, clean towels
10. A record book for keeping the medical record for every day.
11. All other items as required by the person as essential in his daily routine

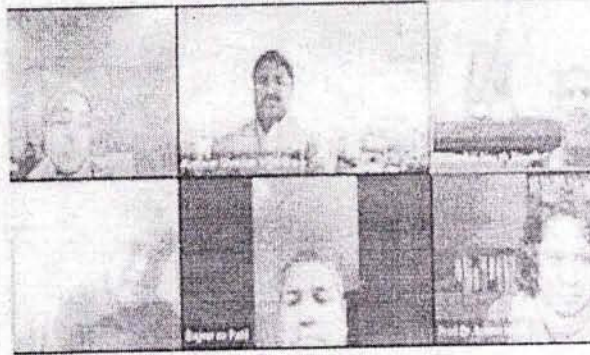
