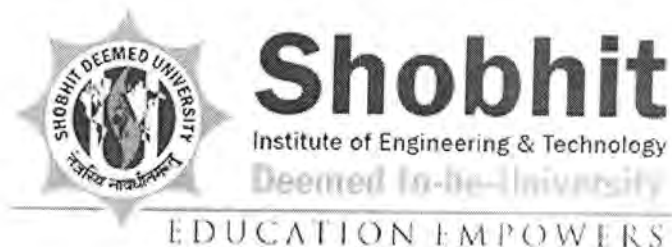

Transplantation can also be a better solution in critical cases. Dr. Manoj Kumar said, we can treat all the problems related to beauty like baldness, gynecomastia, nose lifting etc. with the help of reconstructive medicines. He also told about the techniques used for these. Dr Manoj Kumar told that permanent solution of baldness is possible with Robotic Hair Transplant. Manoj, who has worked in the company, told that in Robotic Hair Transplant, the hair is removed from the back of the head and placed in the front part of the head where there is no hair. In which it costs ₹ 20 per hair, 60 hairs are planted in 1 square centimeter, the doctor told that baldness is genetic, it cannot be stopped, it can be slowed down by proper diet

University

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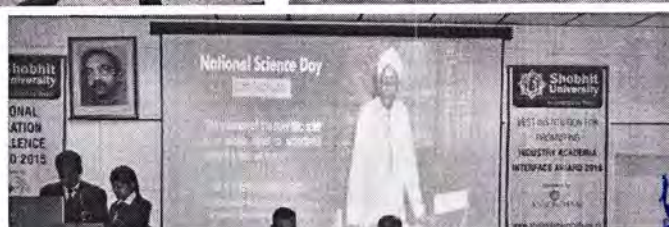

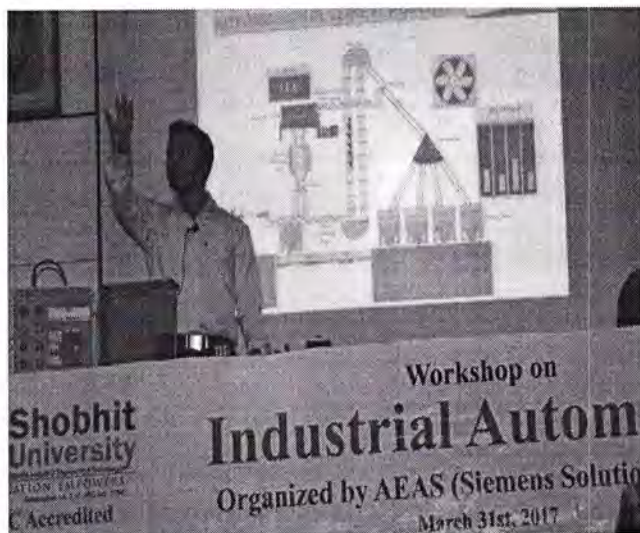
15. One day Industrial Automation Workshop organized

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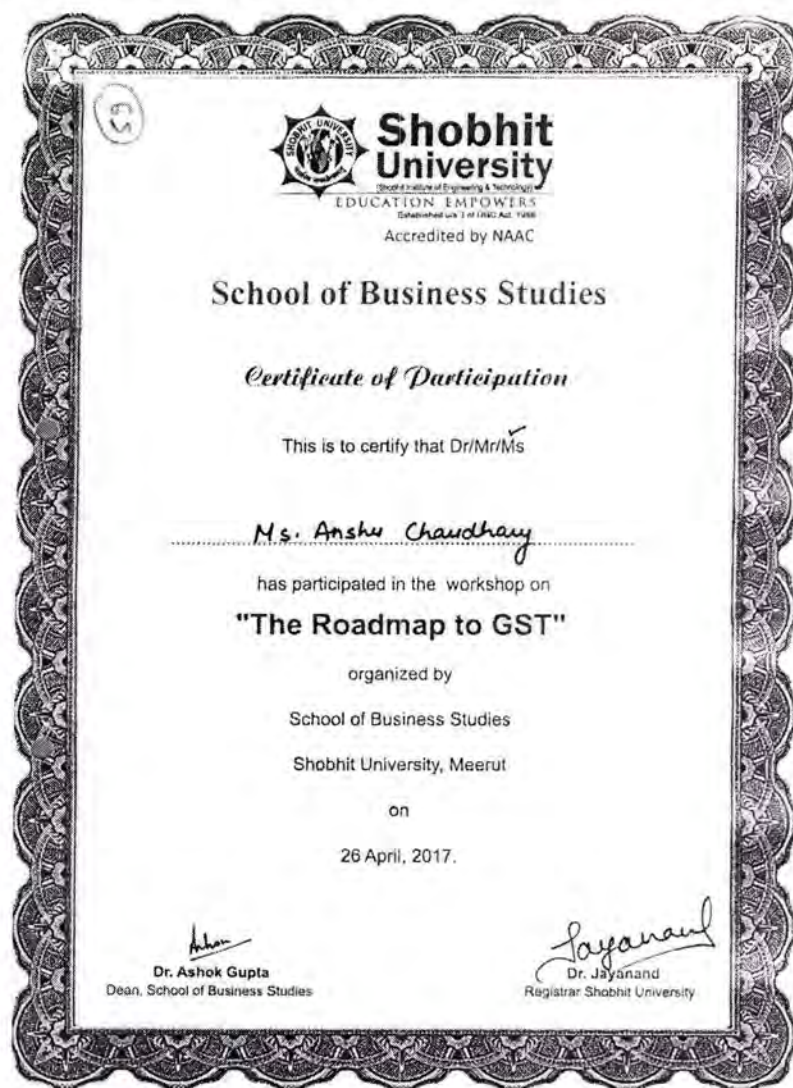

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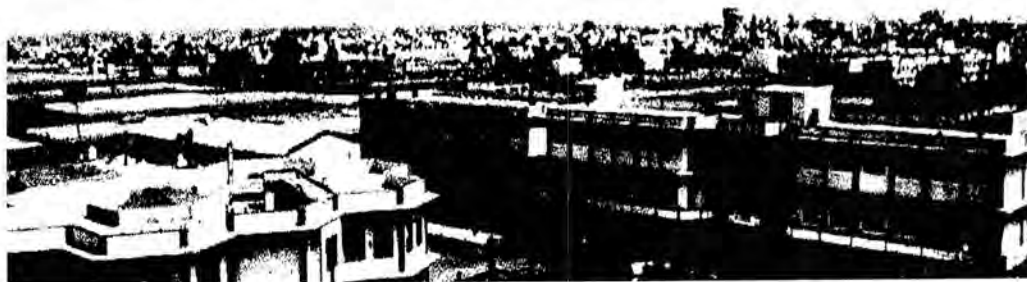

However, there have been discussions in various forums, regarding this goal as impossible and unrealistic. Through the 2016-17 Conference, the University desires to bring in all the stakeholders associated with research, education, development, and extension of the Farming Sector to deliberate on as to how digital technologies, especially Digital Technologies, for creating a major economic impact in the Farming sector which will facilitate income to the Farming Community. Faculty and students are sometimes disconnected from the real needs of industries, especially industries in different countries of the world. 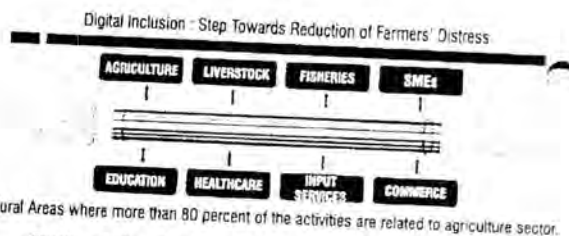
